District:

In Cllr Neesam's absence Cllr Roper gave a brief report.

Broadland District Council and South Norfolk District Council will be moving to the Horizon building on Broadland Business Park.

Anyone that hasn't yet received their £150 council tax rebate will be contacted in writing by BDC. If contact cannot be made the £150 will come off a Council Tax payment.

County:

Cllr Roper told those present that Mansom Plantation had not been selected for mineral extraction. This was thought to be great news for the village.

The deadline for the Highways Safety scheme funding is 25th November, giving Council a chance to get their arguments together.

021 (007) Clerks report

- a) Clerk had received a phone call from Environmental Health about the bonfires that had been reported down Shortthorn Rd. The perpetrators have been issued with a warning and should anyone see any further bonfires coming from the site they should contact BDC.

- c) Deer signs. The clerk had spoken to the clerk from Hainford and had been told that the deer signs on Waterloo Road had been placed there by an unknown resident. It was also noted that new Caution Deer signs have been placed on the A140, near recent accident spots.
